Eureka Prepares EIR for GPU and CAP

The City of Eureka initiated a comprehensive update of its General Plan in late 2013 to define a common vision for the City's future and a strategy to make that vision a reality. Eureka has made substantial progress on the General Plan Update and is now prepared to complete the environmental analysis of the General Plan Update and Climate Action Plan (CAP) for the City. When complete, the environmental impact report (EIR) will provide an evaluation of the potential environmental impacts of the proposed project, along with appropriate mitigation measures that will influence the General Plan Update and CAP. The goal is to enhance the community's quality of life, economic vitality, social well-being, and environmental resources.


This environmental impact report will address:

The Role of the EIR

This EIR will examine potential environmental impacts of the General Plan and CAP and provide mitigation measures. Once certified, it will shape the development of the General Plan and CAP, likely influencing several General Plan policies and programs and CAP strategies.
